



CRIANZA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This wine is sourced from Tupungato, one of the premium areas in the Uco Valley. Produced using winemaking techniques that enhance its great expression and varietal character. A Cabernet Sauvignon carrying Mendoza's essence, reflecting both tradition and modernity.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

LOCATION

Vineyards located in Tupungato, in the renowned Uco Valley region.

HARVEST

Manual harvest into 500-kilo (1,100 lb.) plastic bins.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation in medium-sized concrete vats at a controlled temperature and short maceration to achieve high fruit intensity and freshness.

AGING Six months in oak.

PAIRING

Game stews, aged cheeses and cold cuts. Roasted vegetables. Chocolate and nuts.

AGING POTENTIAL More than 3 years.

TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby red.

Aromas of red pepper, wild berries and spices, enhanced by well-integrated wood. Elegant and mouth-filling body, with noticeable tannins paving the way for a persistent, silky aftertaste, making it a highly versatile Cabernet: the perfect combination between modernity and tradition in winemaking.
